ONLINE REGISTRATION

Registration needs to be done online via **Play Football** at www.playfootball.com.au. Payment is made directly to the club.

PAYMENT

Blue Lake Soccer Club require fees to be paid **10 days prior** to a player participating in an official LCFA match. Registration fees contain a LCFA component + Club component.

The club component of the fees cover: utilities, maintenance to the grounds, surrounds & clubrooms, insurance, uniforms, balls and training equipment, first aid kits, affiliation, lease of grounds.
